Update on Affordable Housing Study

On Monday, May 8th there was a full house to hear about the possibility of affordable housing in the Waldo area (a 14 mile radius from the church). A gentleman from Market Foresight provided us with an extremely detailed report concerning a number of metrics.

Below are some of the highlights.

- There is a need for independent, assisted and even nursing home care in our area.
- The conclusion, which surprised some people is that our area is considered affluent. That means that people are likely looking for amenities in these facilities. It does need to be noted that this area contains a fair amount of farm land which adds tremendous value to individual assets. The assumption is that the house/land would be sold when people are ready to downsize.
- Our goal remains to provide affordable SENIOR housing, which might be 30% of a persons income. You could look at the study as good news. If the Waldo area could sustain more affluent senior housing, affordable housing is also a possibility.
- The next step will be to have another meeting with United Church Homes.
 They are the organization that would manage such a facility and help acquire grants to make this housing a possibility.
- This is the very beginning of a long process, which may or may not come to fruition. We will let you know updates and future meeting times.
