There is no heart like the heart of Jesus, Filled with a tender lore; Not a throb or throe our hearts can know But he suffered before.


There is no voice like the voice of Jesus; Ah! how sweet its chime. Like the musical ring of some rushing spring In the summer-time!



Update on Affordable Housing Study

We first received a feasibility report for the Waldo area that affirmed that Assisted Living/Independent housing for seniors was practical from a financial standpoint.

That study did not address our desire for decent affordable housing for seniors. So on June 7th a session was held with United Church Homes. They depend on government grants for their work. An application fee is \$50,000 whether approved or not. United Church homes was honest that a partnership with them was not a possibility given our parameters. ...God has opened another *possible* door. Watch for more updates!

Preschool Update

A working fire alarm panel has been installed in the church office. It has been tested and approved by the Fort Morrow Fire Department. The next step is to get in touch with the architect again so that he can submit plans and paperwork to the state. It will be approved or they will come back and tell us what needs to be done to meet their standards. If things would progress, the preschool could possibly open in the Fall of 2024. The key is that we have to know by early 2024 if everything is in place to accept registrations and hire staff. A congregational vote will be taken after we receive the states decision.
